 - b. He will not threaten or intimidate the complainant and other witnesses related with the case and will not the prosecution witnesses;
 - c. Accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court till the investigation is over;
 - d. Accused will further not enter in the premises of TERI till the completion of investigation in the case.

That the Applicant till date has been meticulously complying with the conditions as stated in the order dated 21.03.2015 and it shall be pertinent to mention here that the LO/police intercognized the Applicant on several occasions only after they were directed to expedite the investigation while adjudicating the modification application preferred by the Applicant. The Applicant was interrogated by the LO and other officials. The Applicant has thoroughly cooperated in the investigation to the best of his abilities. 


